

# **Mongolian and Tibetan Affairs Commission's Scholarship for Overseas Tibetan Students Application 2009, Open with immediate effect**

Application method is as follows:

1. Qualification of the applicant:

- (1) Ethnic Tibetan.
- (2) Non- resident of Taiwan.
- (3) Resident of area or country other than China.
- (4) Presently studying in School/College/University.
- (5) Diligent student.

2. Application procedure and deadline:

The qualified students may apply either through related overseas Tibetan Schools, Tibetan organizations or group's recommendation, or to the Commission directly. The deadline of the acceptance of the recommendation or direct application is before June 30, 2009.

3. The scholarship quota of each grade and amount:

- (1) Above University: Maximum 12 students for each academic year will be selected and each student will be awarded scholarship of US\$1000.
- (2) Senior High School (10th grade to 12th grade): Maximum 10 students for each academic year will be selected and each student will be awarded scholarship of US\$200.
- (3) Below 9th grade: Maximum 12 students for each academic year will be selected and each student will be awarded scholarship of US\$100.

4. The Applicant has to fill up an application form and submit following documents:

- (1) The original marks-card (school report card) of previous academic year with standard grading system of your college/university/school. (Marks-card will be returned after evaluation; first year University/College students must submit the marks-card of the last semester of previous education level. Copy of the marks-card of the applicants above high school grade must be attested with school's seal on it.)
- (2) Copy of student's identity card or bona fide student certificate.
- (3) 1 passport-size photograph without cap, taken within past three months.
- (4) Applicant must provide personal Bank account Information and detailed personal contact address and telephone number.

5. All the application documents must be submitted before the deadline date, which will be based on the postage date, and application received after the deadline will not be considered for scholarship.
